Public Comment

Approval of meeting minutes of February 13, 2024

Request to extend term of CPA Grant for Residences at St. James

The North Shore CDC submitted a request to extend the CPA grant term for the Residences at St. James for an additional two years.

Ms. Livramento-Bryan asked if the request meant that the CDC has not spent any money yet from their grant. Ms. Kelleher replied in the affirmative.

Mr. Hoskins asked if the CDC would still be required to continue providing status updates on their project. Ms. Kelleher replied in the affirmative.

Mr. Callahan asked if the funds would be returned to the City if the CDC did not spend the funds. Ms. Kelleher replied in the affirmative.

MOTION/VOTE: Ms. Hamilton made a motion to extend the CPA grant term. Ms. Livramento-Bryant seconded the motion, all were in favor and the motion so carried.
