- There is a desire to have a tour of the islands so we can digitize the map and help mobilize volunteers and identify sponsors/potential sponsors
- We should include council people in a tour of the islands and program
- Last Islands bulb planting was finished near Lafayette park, at the top on the corner of Lafayette and Washington
- No pan-handling signs have been spotted downtown, included Washington St median
