

Board of Commissioners of Trust Funds
Minutes of the June 13, 2019 Meeting

The meeting was called to order at 5:30 P.M. in the Mayor's Office, City Hall.

The Council on Aging submitted a request for medication expense reimbursement for two Salem residents. Richard Lobsitz made a motion to pay \$166.33 from the Endicott Fund for the expenses. The motion was seconded by William P. Goreham and voted unanimously.

Sumner Jones made a motion to approve the minutes of the May 9, 2019 meeting. The motion was seconded by Thaddeus Buczko and voted unanimously.
