#330 - An Ordinance Amending the Rates for Use of Water – Effective July 1, 2018 the rates shall be as follows: Residential per 100 Cubic Feet \$3.31 and Non-Residential per 100 Cubic Feet \$4.48; The minimum rate for residential metered water for each quarter shall be \$33.10 per 1000 cubic feet. The use of all water and sewer funds and SESD funds shall be excluded from all private development projects.

#331 - An Ordinance Amending the Sewer Use Charges -Effective July 1, 2018 the rates shall be as follows: Residential per 100 cubic feet \$6.71, nonresidential per 100 cubic feet up to 25,000 cubic feet per month \$10.61 and nonresidential per 100 cubic feet for 25,000 cubic feet and greater per month \$13.01. The use of all water and sewer funds and SESD funds shall be excluded from all private development projects.


