December 7, 2016 meeting of the City Council Committee on Community and Economic Development co-posted with the Committee of the Whole convened at 6:00 p.m. Absent from the committee were: David Eppley. Present from the COW was at-large Councillor Tom Furey Present from the community and administration were Tom Daniel, Director, Planning and Community Development, Matt Smith, Director, Traffic and Parking. Rinus Oosthoek, Salem Chamber and Kiley Sullivan, Salem Main Streets. A letter from Kate Fox, Destination Salem, was read into the record by Councillor Famico. Conversation centered around different rates that are charged in Salem, Salem's inventory of parking spaces and in particular, should we sell parking passes to hotels. Matt Smith gave us information on the data that is currently available through the automated system and different types of data that can be culled from the system in the future. After a lengthy discussion, Councillor Famico moved to keep the matter in committee, seconded by councillor Ryan. The matter passed unanimously.
