Granting of certain licenses: Junk Dealer, Seaworms, Second Hand Clothing, Second Hand Valuables and Tag Days

Councilor Morsillo informed the committee that as per a conversation with David Greenbaum, the Health Agent, all groups participating in Tag Days will be informed of the following guidelines: all participants must be behind a table, with donation containers remaining on the table. People wishing to make a donation should place the money into the container on the table, and not hand it to a student or adult. No one should be approached for a donation. All participants should try to maintain a 6 foot distance from others. And any and all state mandates regarding shut downs must be obeyed.

Councilor Sargent moves to refer this out to the full Council with a recommendation for approval, seconded by Councilor Dominguez, voted 5-0, motion passes.
