C Riccardi Opened the meeting at 6:45pm

B Renard provided an update to the Committee that feedback was provided by the building inspector late last night to her and there is not enough time to thoroughly respond to his comments. She is requesting support from a legal zoning consultant to assist with his comments and how to best revise. It has been requested to Tom to provide these comments in writing and they will then be reviewed by the City Solicitor. B Renard also noted a few items that are currently in the draft might better live in the Board of Health Regulations. This will also be reviewed.

C Riccardi thanked D Greenbaum for having the Urban Ag ordinance discussed at the July Board of Health Meeting. He confirmed this discussion and said the board was in generally in favor of the ordinance. They are looking forward to reviewing the draft and will be able to provide feedback.
