SUBJECT(S)

ARPA (American Rescue Plan Act) Program and Funds

Seth Lattrell began the meeting by discussing the public process for the Municipal Harbor Plan, which led to this opportunity for offshore wind and marine industrial use of the unused Footprint property.

John Berry, Terminal Operations Manager for Crowley Wind Services then went on to discuss how they are thinking about the future use of the parcels. They have completed a 10% design and are moving on to a 30% design.

Councilors then had an opportunity to ask questions about the schedule moving forward, employment opportunities, uses after OSW, what needs to be built on the site, the permitting process and the impact on the neighborhood and the port during construction and during operation.

Councilor McCarthy moved for this to remain in committee so that the group can return during the design process to update the City Council. Seconded by Councilor Dominguez, the motion passes 10-0.

On the motion of C. McCarthy the meeting adjourned at 7:33P.M.
