FIRST PASSAGE

In the year two thousand and Thirteen

An Ordinance

relative to municipal board appointments

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Salem, as follows:

Section 1.

Division 1. – Generally of Chapter 2. – Administration, Article IV. – Boards, Commissions, Committees and Authorities is hereby amended by adding the following new section:

"Sec. 2-626. – Appointment to Municipal Boards; Reappointment Requirement. The Mayor shall submit to the city council, within one hundred eighty days (180) days of the expiration of the term of office of any member of a municipal board whose appointment is subject to confirmation by the city council, a letter of reappointment for the municipal board member or a replacement appointee. Any municipal board member whose reappointment has not been filed with the office of the city clerk within one hundred eighty (180) days of the expiration of his or her term shall cease to be a member of the municipal board as his or her term shall have expired."

Section II. This ordinance shall take effect as provided by city charter.
