SECOND PASSAGE

In the year Two Thousand and thirteen

An Ordinance to amend an Ordinance relative to Boards, Commissions, Committees and Authorities

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Salem, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 2 Division 1 – Administration, Article IV - Boards, Commissions, Committees and Authorities is hereby amended by adding the follows:

“Sec. 2-626. – Appointment to Municipal boards; Reappointment Requirement. The Mayor shall submit to the City Council, within one hundred twenty (120) days of the expiration of the term of office of any member of a municipal board whose appointment is subject to confirmation by the City Council, a letter of reappointment for the municipal board member or a replacement appointee. Any municipal board member whose reappointment has not been filed with the office of the City Clerk within one twenty (120) days of the expiration of his or her term shall cease to be a member of the municipal board as his or her term shall have expired unless a waiver of this section is granted by the City Council.”

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect as provided by City Charter.
