## An Grdinance

to amend an Ordinance relative to Traffic, Chapter 42 Section 51B, "Parking Prohibited at Certain Times on Certain Streets" and Section 75, "Parking Prohibitions Towing Zone, Resident Sticker"

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Salem, as follows:

## Section 1.

Repeal Section 51B, Chestnut Street southerly side from Cambridge Street in an easterly direction for a distance of fifty (50) feet. One hour parking from 8:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M., Monday through Friday. (819/64)

**Section 2.** Repeal Section 51B, Chestnut Street southerly side, in a westerly direction, from Summer Street for a distance of sixty (60) feet. One hour parking from 8:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M. Monday through Friday (4/23/81)

**Section 3.** Repeal Section 75, Chestnut Street Zone D-Color Yellow Resident Sticker Parking Tow Zone, eastbound on both sides Northerly and Southerly from Cambridge Street to Summer Street. (4/14/2005)

**Section 4.** Repeal Section 75, Chestnut Street Zone D-Color Yellow from Flint Street to Summer Street, limited to 2 hours by non-residents. (11/10/86)

**Section 5.** This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by City Charter.
