NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING Under the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act & the City of Salem Wetlands Protection Ordinance

A Public Hearing will be held at Salem City Hall Annex, 120 Washington St, 3rd fl., Salem, MA at 6pm on July 24, 2014, to consider a Notice of Intent for New England Power Company (d/b/a National Grid), for the Salem Cable Replacement Project located between the Salem Harbor and Canal Street Substations. Portions of the work will take place in existing city streets, in Fort Avenue, Webb Street, Essex Street, Forrester Street, Hawthorne Boulevard, Congress Street, Derby Street, Leavitt Street, Cypress Street, Canal Street, and Washington Street. The proposed work on these streets fall within resource areas jurisdictional to the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act and the Salem Wetlands Protection and Conservation Ordinance, including Land Subject to Coastal Storm Flowage (100-year floodplain), the 100-foot Buffer Zone to Floodplain (under the local ordinance only), Riverfront Area, and the 100-foot Buffer Zone to Bank.

This is a public hearing under the requirements of G.L. Ch 131 Section 40, as amended, and the Salem Wetlands Protection Ordinance and Regulations. Plans are available at the City of Department of Planning and Community Development, City Hall Annex, 120 Washington Street, 3rd floor, Salem, MA from 8am—4pm Mondays thru Wednesdays, 8am—7pm on Thursdays, and 8am—12pm(noon) on Fridays.
