Second Passage

The full text of the ordinance is set forth below and may be examined and obtained in the City Clerk's Office, 93 Washington Street, Salem, MA.

In the year Two Thousand and Twenty-Two

An Ordinance to amend the zoning ordinance regarding buffer zones relative to marijuana establishments.

Section 1. Section 6.10.6 of the Code of Zoning Ordinances is amended by replacing (5) in its entirety with the following:

“5. Pursuant to M.G.L.A. c. 94G, § 5(b)(3), a marijuana establishment shall not be located within five hundred (500) feet of a pre-existing public or private school providing education in kindergarten or any of grades 1 through 12.”

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by City Charter.

Referred to the Planning Board for their review and recommendation by a roll call vote of 11 yeas, 0 nays and 0 absent

In City Council March 24, 2022

Adopted for first passage by a roll call vote of 10 yeas, 1 nay and 0 absent

In City Council April 14, 2022

Adopted for second passage by a roll call vote of 10 yeas, 1 nay and 0 absent

Approved by the Mayor on April 19, 2022

Any claims of invalidity by reason of any defect in the procedure of adoption may only be made within ninety days after the posting or the second publication.
