Will hold a public hearing for all persons interested in the petition of DEMETRA KARLIS (A/KOUNSALIEH), TRUSTEE at 152-156 DERBY STREET (Map 35, Lot 348) (B1 Zoning District) for a Variance per Section 5.1.8 Table of Required Parking Spaces to delete the requirement in the December 30, 2013, Board of Appeals decision that the owner lease three (3) off-site parking spaces within a reasonable distance of the residential units. Petitioner proposes to change present nonconforming use as a first-floor restaurant with 2 dwelling units above subject to a condition to lease off-street parking to the same use with no requirement to lease off-street parking.
