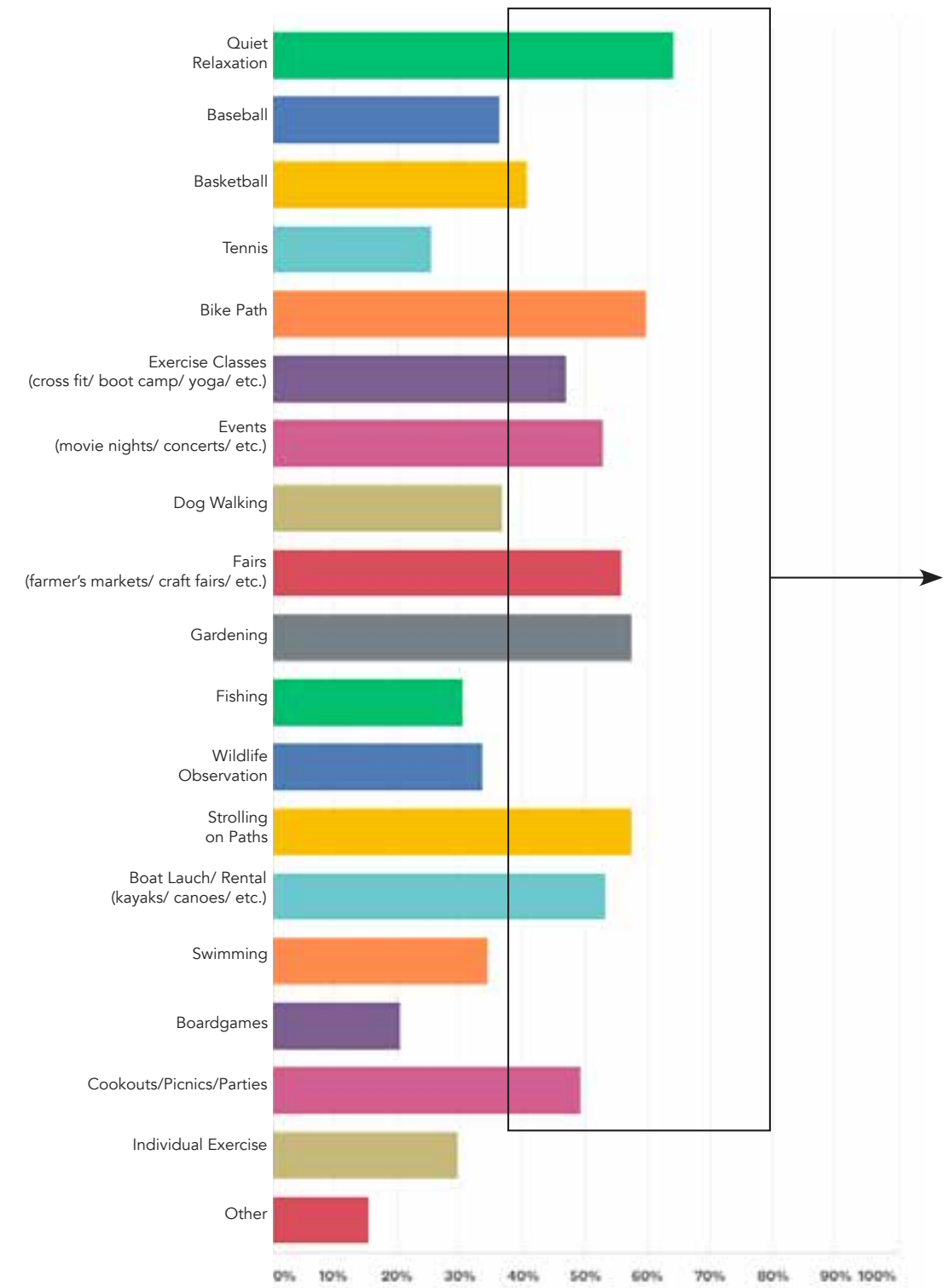




2018 Public Engagement
