## Sewer and Drainage Structure Repairs

- 1. This bid request is solicited to the general public and a contract will be awarded pursuant to the rules set forth in Chapter 30, Section 39M of the Massachusetts General Laws and subject to the approval by the Mayor of Salem, Mass.
- 2. The envelope containing the bid and required information must be sealed and marked with bidder's name, description of bid, bid number and date of opening.
- 3. All bidders must sign attestation clause regarding Massachusetts State tax returns and certificate of non-collusion and submit it with their Bid. Failure to sign or submit the Non-Collusion Certificate with the bid will be cause for that bid to be rejected.
- 4. A bidder may correct, modify, or withdraw a bid by sealed, written notice clearly marked as a correction, modification, or withdrawal and received in the Office of the Salem Purchasing Agent prior to the time and date set for the bid opening.
- 5. BID DEPOSIT: A bid deposit of 5% of the total bid must accompany the bid package. The bid deposit must be made payable to the City of Salem in the form of a Bid Bond, Cash, or Certified Check. All Bid Deposits will be returned after contract award.
- 6. Failure to respond to this bid, either with prices or by returning a "no bid" response, will result in the bidder not automatically receiving bid materials for the next year's orders.
- 7. Bid quotations must show the net delivered cost to the City of Salem on the front of the Cover Sheet and sign the bottom of it as well.
- 8. #### Scope of Work:

A map has been provided to identity several structures that may be repaired as part of this project, depending on the priorities of the City and the available budget, additional structures will be identified in writing thought the contract period. The quantities of work tabulated in this Bid or indicated on the Details or in Specifications or other Contract Documents are only approximate and are subject to increase or decrease as deemed necessary by the City and the undersigned agrees that, if this Bid is accepted he will contract with the Owner, as provided in the copy of the Contract Documents in this Bid Form being part of said Contract, and that he will perform all the work and furnish all the materials and equipment, and provide all labor, services, plant, machinery, apparatus, appliances, tools, supplies and all other things required in the manner and time prescribed and according to the requirements of the City as therein set forth, and that he will take in full payment therefore the lump sum or unit price applicable to each item of work.

Repair or reconstruction of drain structures in excess of 12 vertical inches below the casting flange will be measured for payment under <a href="Item No. 2 - Reconstruct Drain Structures - Corbels and Walls.">Item No. 2 - Reconstruct Drain Structures - Corbels and Walls.</a>. Reconstruction of drain structures - corbels or walls without prior approval or completed as part of Item Nos. 3 and 4 work will not be measured for payment.

#### B. Payment

Payment for Item No. 1 – Repair Structures – Chimneys or Risers shall be based on the unit price bid for this item in the proposal. Under the Unit Price bid for this item, the Contractor shall furnish all labor, materials, tools, equipment, and incidentals required to repair or reconstruct drain structures, as indicated on the Drawings and as specified or as directed by the Engineer. It is anticipated that this work will be completed with hand and power tools, and not requiring excavation equipment. The work includes all labor, tools, equipment, and materials necessary to complete the work; as well as plugging pipes or pumping to de-water structure if required; chipping and chiseling away all loose or deteriorated mortar and masonry, cleaning structure voids of dirt and debris, filling voids with mortar and replacing removed mortar and masonry with new bricks and mortar, application of full surface coat of mortar on reconstructed portion of chimney or riser after repairs have cured; removal and disposal of all construction debris from inside structure; recording pre and post photographs identifying structure ID number for reference, and all incidental work not included for payment elsewhere.

Measurement for payment will be based on the vertical feet of sewer or drain structure (manholes or catch basins) corbels or walls reconstructed as directed and measured and approved by the Engineer. Measurements for payment will be rounded up to the nearest 6-inches (0.5 vertical feet) of structures reconstructed as directed. Reconstruction of drain structures —corbels or walls without prior approval or completed as part of Item Nos. 1, 3, or 4 work will not be measured for payment.

#### B. Payment

Payment for Item No. 2 – Reconstruct Structures – Corbels or Walls shall be based on the unit price bid for this item in the proposal. Under the Unit Price bid for this item, the Contractor shall furnish all labor, materials, tools, equipment, and incidentals required to reconstruct drain structures, as indicated on the Drawings and as specified or as directed by the Engineer. The work includes all labor, tools, equipment, and materials necessary to complete the work; as well as plugging pipes or pumping to de-water structure if required; saw cutting pavement and removal and disposal of asphalt and gravel, removal of existing masonry and chipping and chiseling loose or deteriorated masonry as directed, cleaning surface and voids of dirt and debris; filling voids with mortar and replacing removed mortar and masonry with new mortar and bricks, blocks, or replacement masonry as required; application of full surface coat of mortar on reconstructed portion of corbels or walls; removal and disposal of all construction debris from inside structure; recording pre and post photographs identifying structure ID number for reference, and all incidental work not included for payment elsewhere.

The work includes all labor, tools, equipment, and materials necessary to complete the work; as well as plugging pipes or pumping to de-water structure if required; saw cutting pavement and removal and disposal of asphalt and gravel to remove castings, removal of all masonry and chipping and chiseling away all loose or deteriorated mortar and masonry as directed up to 6 vertical inches below the casting flange, cleaning structure surface and voids of dirt and debris, filling voids with mortar and replacing removed mortar and masonry with new bricks and mortar as required to install new or replacement casting flush and level with existing pavement grade; applying mortar around outside of casting flange; filling excavated hole around outside of casting with compacted bituminous concrete with tack coat and sand on joints, application of full surface coat of mortar on reconstructed portion of chimney or riser after repairs have cured; removal of all construction debris from inside structure; recording pre and post photographs identifying structure ID number for reference, and all incidental work not included for payment elsewhere. Payment for Item No. 4 – Remove and Adjust or Replace Castings, Replace Risers with Polypropylene Rings shall be based on the unit price bid for this item in the proposal. Under the Unit Price bid for this item, the Contractor shall remove existing castings (frames and covers or grates), remove and reset brick and mortar chimneys or risers, and reset castings, higher or lower, as indicated or specified or as directed by the Engineer. A frame and cover/grate set shall be measured as a single casting. A frame and double grate set for double catch basin will be measured as two castings. Castings provided and installed to replace castings damaged by construction will not be measured for payment.

Payment for Item No. 5 – Furnish and Deliver New Manhole or Catch Basin Castings shall be based on the unit price bid for this item in the proposal. Under the Unit Price bid for this item, the Contractor shall provide and deliver H-20 rated cast iron "Sewer" or "Drain" manhole frames and covers or catch basin frames and

grates, as indicated on the Drawings and as specified or as directed by the Engineer. The work includes all labor, tools, equipment, and materials necessary to complete the work; as well as delivery and storage of frames and covers/grates and double catch basin grates as indicated, and re-delivery to the Owner or site of proposed installation, and all incidental work not included for payment elsewhere.







- An Awarding Authority must request an updated wage schedule from the Department of Labor Standards ("DLS") if it has not opened bids or selected a contractor within 90 days of the date of issuance of the wage schedule. For CM AT RISK projects (bid pursuant to G.L. c.149A), the earlier of: (a) the execution date of the GMP Amendment, or (b) the bid for the first construction scope of work must be within 90-days of the wage schedule issuance date.
- The wage schedule shall be incorporated in any advertisement or call for bids for the project as required by M.G.L. c. 149, § 27. The wage schedule shall be made a part of the contract awarded for the project. The wage schedule must be posted in a conspicuous place at the work site for the life of the project in accordance with M.G.L. c. 149 \u2208 27. The wages listed on the wage schedule must be paid to employees performing construction work on the project whether they are employed by the prime contractor, a filed sub-bidder, or any sub-contractor.
- All apprentices working on the project are required to be registered with the Massachusetts Division of Apprentice Standards (DAS). Apprentice must keep his/her apprentice identification card on his/her person during all work hours on the project. An apprentice registered with DAS may be paid the lower apprentice wage rate at the applicable step as provided on the prevailing wage schedule. If an apprentice rate is not listed on the prevailing wage schedule for the trade in which an apprentice is registered with the DAS, the apprentice must be paid the journeyworker's rate for the trade.
- The wage rates will remain in effect for the duration of the project, except in the case of multi-year public construction projects. For construction projects lasting longer than one year, awarding authorities must request an updated wage schedule. Awarding authorities are required to request these updates no later than two weeks before the anniversary of the date the contract was executed by the awarding authority and the general contractor. For multi-year CM AT RISK projects, awarding authority must request an annual update no later than two weeks before the anniversary date, determined as the earlier of: (a) the execution date of the GMP Amendment, or (b) the execution date of the first amendment to permit procurement of construction services. Contractors are required to obtain the wage schedules from awarding authorities, and to pay no less than these rates to covered workers. The annual update requirement is not applicable to 27F "rental of equipment" contracts.
- Every contractor or subcontractor which performs construction work on the project is required to submit weekly payroll reports and a Statement of Compliance directly to the awarding authority by mail or email and keep them on file for three years. Each weekly payroll report must contain: the employee's name, address, occupational classification, hours worked, and wages paid. Do not submit weekly payroll reports to DLS. A sample of a payroll reporting form may be obtained at http://www.mass.gov/dols/pw.
- Contractors with questions about the wage rates or classifications included on the wage schedule have an affirmative obligation to inquire with DLS at (617) 626-6953.
- Employees not receiving the prevailing wage rate set forth on the wage schedule may report the violation to the Fair Labor Division of the office of the Attorney General at (617) 727-3465.
- Failure of a contractor or subcontractor to pay the prevailing wage rates listed on the wage schedule to all employees who perform construction work on the project is a violation of the law and subjects the contractor or subcontractor to civil and criminal penalties.
