Alexander Mitchell-Munavar resigned from the Board of Registrars as he has taken a job which he feels would be in conflict with the Board. City Clerk Irene Simons suggested Chairman Barton and Board member Donald Bates send any replacement recommendations to Mayor Driscoll for consideration.

City Clerk Irene Simons spoke about Sept. 1, 2020 State primary and told Board how much work we did to prepare. Donald Bates said from his observations, the Election went very smoothly.

Clerk Simons - Now that Council meetings have resumed, she is very busy with that. Relies on staff (primarily 2.5 persons) in Elections office to prepare for Elections. Inundated with Vote by mail Applications.

Chairman Barton: Asked about postcards from Secretary Galvin and whether or not postcards are from voters who wanted Sept. ballots also or just Nov. applicants. Also asked if online VBM application portal is just for November 2020.

City Clerk Simons - yes; Postcards for November ballots and online just for November as well. No way to check if voter has already submitted application by mail; system not set up to alert voter if record is a duplicate. Creates so much more work for staff. Waiting for ballots so we can stuff envelopes and mail out. A working group was formed of individuals from various groups/organizations in Salem. (LWV, Voces, ADA, Cheryl LaPointe) helped us prepare and assisted us in getting information to voters.

Costs to run 9/1 Election were exponential and we only had just over 11,000 voters either by mail (8,918), Early In-Person Voting (764), Election Day (4,500). High primary turnout due to VBM.

Early Removal/Deposit very time-consuming, lengthy process. Ballot Collection Boxes will be open once ballots mailed out and remain open until Nov. 3 at 8 PM.

Early Voting + Election Day Nov. 3, 2020: Same process. Have scheduled volunteers. May only early-remove ballots then send to polls for processing on E.D.

Bd. Member Bates: Any indication that "Double-Counting" of ballots occurred or could occur?

City Clerk Simons: Voters try to test the system by requesting mail-in ballots then appearing in person to vote. We have process to make sure only one ballot is cast per voter. Our database knows a person may have been issued two ballots; we reject one so they only vote one ballot.

-changing position/configuration of AutoMark Voting Assistance Machine to ensure accessibility and privacy, according to ADA. Chris Nagle of ADA will come and make sure we are in compliance and it is easily accessible.

Costs (All figures approximate): Overtime \$15,250 (3)

Early Voting + Advanced Tabulation \$7,900; Ballot Collection Boxes \$9,400 (will be reimbursed by State); PPE \$5,700; Poll Pads \$1,600; Voter transportation Bus \$520; Signage \$2,400. Miscellaneous \$1,700; Ballot postage paid by Building Department \$.70/ballot.

\$50,000 approx for 9/1/20

\$30,000 approx for 11/3/20

We will be receiving a grant of around \$25,000.

Hope to purchase new voting machines w/ CIP money. Could cost around \$100,000. FY21 funds to go in for Jan, 2021.

C. Barton - Schedule demonstration of new equipment  
City Clerk Simons - demonstration was to be in March, but cancelled due to shutdown. Reschedule for Feb 2021

Judith Reilly - Dem City Committees can supply list for potential board member replacement.

C. Barton - already have a member from each Party. New member can be from either Party or Unenrolled.

D. Bates - Can reach out to Dem & Rep Chairs for potential new member.

J. Reilly - Concerned with Security of future voting Equipment. Still using Paper ballots?

City Clerk Simons - Still paper ballots; just new machines.

C. Barton - Need to have backup.

City Clerk Simons - Always have Printout of everything. That's why we print out email ballots.
