  - a. **Traffic Ordinance Recommendations**
    - i. **Discussion and Recommendation: Holyoke Square On-Street Parking Regulations** –As part of a host community agreement with CDX Analytics (marijuana testing company) approximately 7 on street parking spaces along the west side of Holyoke Square from Norman Street to Gedney Street will be returned to the City for public use. In anticipation of this, the Commission will consider a proposed ordinance change to restrict parking to a two (2) hour limit similar to what is already in place along the east side of the street.
    - ii. **Discussion and Recommendation: Bike Lane Parking Restrictions** – Prior to the opening of the ATG Marijuana Dispensary (50 Grove St), temporary parking was permitted along the eastbound side of Harmony Grove where a buffered bike lane exists. MGL Chapter 89 Section 4D states, “*The operator of a motor vehicle shall not stand or park the vehicle upon an on-street path or lane designated by an official sign or marking for the exclusive use of bicycles, except in a case of emergency*”. In an effort to raise public awareness of State law the Commission will consider whether an ordinance change to prohibit parking should be proposed.
  - b. **Discussion and Recommendation: Downtown Valet Parking Pilot** – Staff recently met with Mayor and local business to discuss re-submitting an ordinance to the City Council that would create a pilot program for valet parking in downtown.
  - c. **Discussion: Traffic and Parking Commission Regulations** – The Commission will review and discuss the proposed regulations and ordinance.
