    - **ii. Motorcoach Parking Ordinance** The Commission will consider staff recommendations to change the existing motorcoach parking ordinance to ensure that the ordinance and existing parking signs are in line with one another, as well as some additions to the ordinance.
  - **c.** Village Tavern Shuttle Proposal The owners of the Village Tavern (168 Essex Street) have petitioned the City to be allowed to operate a shuttle to and from their establishment that would traverse the Essex Street Pedestrian Mall to embark and discharge passengers.
