 - i. Discussion and Recommendation: Gedney Street Area Parking Meters Last year the Commission made a recommendation re: parking on Gedney Street and the nearby area with the condition that staff meet with the neighboring businesses to discuss the proposal. Those meetings have been conducted, and staff will present a slightly modified plan based on the feedback we have received.
 - Discussion and Recommendation: Mill Street Tactical Bicycle Infrastructure The newly completed section of the Canal Street Multiuse Path currently ends at Mill Street along the southern edge of Riley Plaza. There is no bike infrastructure on Mill Street, nor are there any bike markings on the road. There needs to be a long-term plan for how cyclists move from the path to and through downtown, but we also need a short-term plan as the weather improves and more people will be using the path soon.
 - Staff Presentation and Discussion: Resident and Visitor Permit Parking Staff will present the research memo they have written on the City's current processes as well as potential best practices from other municipalities. This is intended to be the first of many meetings on this topic, both with the Commission and with the public via meetings with neighborhood groups and residents.
 - **Staff Presentation and Discussion: Neighborhood Traffic Calming Program** Staff has an updated memo outlining the Neighborhood Traffic Calming Program process and the Commission will discuss the memo as well as any proposed changes or suggestions.
