 - a. Traffic Calming Projects: Valley Street and River Street Residents of Valley Street and River Street have requested traffic calming work through the Neighborhood Traffic Calming Program. And in both cases a first potential phase would include new stop signs. Stop signs require an ordinance change recommendation if they will be permanent, so the Commission will discuss if these changes should be permanent, or if a trial period would be more suitable.
 - **b.** Maintaining Sidewalk Access At the Request of Commission Vice-Chair Papetti, the Commission will begin a discussion about maintaining sidewalk access in the City.
 - c. Request for Traffic Ordinance Recommendations
 - i. Discussion and Recommendation: Parking Near a Crosswalk At the last meeting, the Commission discussed pursuing an ordinance change that would prohibit parking within a certain distance of a crosswalk, similar to how parking is prohibited within twenty (20) feet of an intersection. The Commission will consider a proposed ordinance change to prohibit parking within ten (10) feet of a crosswalk.
