 - **Canal St. Multi-Use Path Project** Update the Committee on the changes made to the design and construction for the Canal St. path. Share the AECOM letter to the Conservation Committee regarding the changes to the path.
 - MassDOT Complete Streets Grant Program Share the Complete Streets grant guidelines and eligible projects presentation. Opportunity for the City to fund complete construction of Separated Bike Lanes, bicycle parking, new and improvement of shared use paths (Collins Cove path repair), and striping for bike lanes/sharrows.
 - MAPC Master Plan Update/Funding for Engineering MAPC has begun to update the Master Plan to reflect Vision: 2020 and new develops Salem has completed and committed to for cycling. We are hoping to schedule a September meeting to discuss MAPC's progress and plans, and also look to implementing a pilot separated lane for a Fall pilot.

The City is also requesting funding from the City Council to pay for FST design engineering to create plans for a permanent separated bicycle lane on 2-3 main roads in Salem to support the upcoming Complete Streets grant funding opportunity from MassDOT.

• Collins Cove Path Extension and Repair – Discuss the potential to repair the Collins Cove path as well as connecting the path across Szetela Ln., through the undeveloped City-owned parcel where the gas line is going, across Fort and through Beattie Park so it connects with Derby St. Discuss the letter member D. Bowie is drafting to send to Footprint to urge them to help make that connection. Algonquin gas has begun work to dig through the parcel for the line and as part of the

agreement with the City there will be a path through that property
