ORDER: That the Salem City Council consider naming Veteran Squares as endorsed by the Veterans Council for the following list of Veterans who paid the ultimate sacrifice during WWII:

<u>Groves Square</u>: to be located at the intersection of High Street and Beach Street in Ward 1. C. Dexter Groves lived at 32 Beach Avenue before he enlisted in the Marine Corps just after Pearl Harbor on 5 January 1942. Private Groves was killed in action on 25 October 1942 during the invasion of Guadalcanal in the Pacific Theater.

<u>Coyne Square</u>: to be located at the intersection of Bay View Ave near Chaput Beach in Ward 1. Charles L. Coyne enlisted in the Merchant Marines on 19 September 1942. He was killed in action on 4 May 1943 when his ship, the USAT Oneida, was sunk by a Japanese submarine.

J.J. Murphy Square: to be located at the intersection of Juniper Ave. and Star Avenue in Ward 1. John J. Murphy enlisted in the Navy on 27 February 1941. While flying a mission out of Pearl Harbor as a U.S. Navy pilot, his plane was reporting missing on 28 March 1943. He was declared officially dead on 29 March 1944.

<u>**Griffin Square**</u>: to be located at the intersection of Columbus Avenue and Bay View Avenue in Ward 1. Robert F. Griffin lived on Columbus Avenue (Ward 1) before leaving for WWII. He enlisted in the Navy after graduating high school in 1943. He was assigned as a 'belly gunner' in a Navy aircraft that was lost on a mission over the Philippines on 9 July 1945.

Jodoin Square: to be located at the intersection of Wheatland Street and Jefferson Ave. in Ward 3. Henry Jodoin enlisted in the Army on 18 March 1944 and was killed in action while fighting in Germany on 16 December 1944.

<u>Malionek Square</u>: to be located at the intersection of Blaney Street and Derby Street in Ward 1. PFC Chester Malionek enlisted in the US Army on 24 mar 1943 and was killed in action on 22 December 1944 during the Battle of Hurtgen Forest in Grosshau, Germany.
