My name is Tom Mistretta. I am a race director at the Wicked Running Club. I am contacting you regarding the Wicked Running Club's "Miles Over The Moon" (MOTM) running race. This race has been held in Salem for nine years. I have been Race Director for MOTM for the last five years. We are most grateful for the support of the City of Salem for this race. This letter is requesting permission to run the race again in Salem in 2020, specifically Friday evening, July 17, 2020.

We propose to hold this race on Friday evening, July 17, 2020. The race will begin at 8PM and end around 9:15PM.

100% of the proceeds from the race go to the Wicked Youth Running Fund. This fund supports the free "Wicked Kidz" running race, an event for children which itself is also held in the City of Salem.
