**PETITION FOR JOINT OR IDENTICAL POLE LOCATIONS**

To the City Council  
Of Salem, Massachusetts

Massachusetts Electric Company d/b/a National Grid and Verizon New England, Inc requests permission to locate poles, wires, and fixtures, including the necessary sustaining and protecting fixtures, along and across the following public way:

Orange Street - National Grid to install 1 JO Pole on Orange St beginning at a point approximately 160 feet south of the centerline of the intersection of Essex St & Orange St and continuing approximately 10 feet in a west direction. Customer at 7 Curtis St is requesting a pole relocation. In order to accommodate this request National Grid will need to add an additional pole in the city right of way.

Location approximately as shown on plan attached

Wherefore it prays that after due notice and hearing as provided by law, it be granted a location for and permission to erect and maintain poles and wires, together with such sustaining and protecting fixtures as it may find necessary, said poles to be erected substantially in accordance with the plan filed herewith marked – Orange St - Salem – Massachusetts.

**Dear Parks and Recreation and Mr. Candelaria,**

**My name is Tom Mistretta. I am a race director at the Wicked Running Club. I am contacting you regarding the Wicked Running Club's "Miles Over The Moon" (MOTM) running race. This race has been held in Salem for nine years. I have been Race Director for MOTM for the last five years. We are most grateful for the support of the City of Salem for this race. This letter is requesting permission to run the race again in Salem in 2020, specifically Friday evening, July 17, 2020.**

**We propose to hold this race on Friday evening, July 17, 2020. The race will begin at 8PM and end around 9:15PM.**

**100% of the proceeds from the race go to the Wicked Youth Running Fund. This fund supports the free "Wicked Kidz" running race, an event for children which itself is also held in the City of Salem. In addition, the fund provides donations to local High School athletic programs and for academic scholarships. In 2018, the board of the Wicked Running Club voted to provide funds to Salem's High School athletic program every year that MOTM is held in the City of Salem. This Salem donation would be in addition to any other local city or town athletic program. More details on race financials can be found later in this letter.**

**As per the application, you will see attached to this packet a diagram of the race through the City of Salem. The race begins and ends at the Bentley School, 25 Memorial Drive in Salem. In the past two years, Ryan Monks at the Buildings and Grounds department has given his approval for us to use the school parking lot(s) for this event.**

Restaurant Row, take Right onto Fort Ave

Szetela West to Essex  
Essex Right to Washington Square East  
Washington Square East to Left into Salem Common  
Salem Common clockwise loop to Left on Pleasant  
Pleasant to Right on Bridge  
Bridge to Right on Osgood**

Osgood to Right on East Collins St.  
East Collins Street to Right on Bike Path  
Bike Path to Left on Szetela running East  
Finish at Bentley School
