Enrollment Update

• 340 total student, waitlists vary from 61 in K to 5 for Grade 5.

Human Resources

• Offer made to new special ed teacher.

Professional Development

• Planning to hire Aspire (Boston Univ) to train teachers in cultural competency.

Family / Community Update

• Completed 126 home visits, accounting for 37% of scholars. Home visits include meeting anywhere outside of school facilities, to establish stronger bond between educators and parents.

Academic Report

- Continue using STEP assessment to measure scholar reading level achievement.
- Anet system used for English Language Arts and Math for grades 2-5.

Accountability Reporting

- Discontinue using 1-5 scale
- Accountability percentiles and progress toward targets
- Categories and weights as follows:
 - Achievement 60%: ELA, Math and Science
 - Student Growth 20%: ELA mean student growth percentile (SGP), Mathematics mean SGP
 - English Proficiency: % of students meeting targets to attain English language proficiency within 6 years
 - Additional 10%: absenteeism
- Reviewed DESE reporting systems for school accountability
 - Don't compare 2018 accountability to historical data not based on the same data and measurement criteria

Committee Updates

• **Finance Committee**: all portable air conditioning units installed in classrooms. DP asked whether committee should investigate funding commercial grade portable units for library and cafeteria. DP requested estimated costs for de-installation of units in late fall, ahead of winter season.
