

Reduce Wrapping Waste

- -Reuse old wrapping paper
- -Use newspaper, old maps, brown paper bags, old calendars, pages from magazines, scarves, textile scraps, etc. If you're looking for some sparkle, wash empty potato chip bags and wrap the gifts shiny/silver side up!
- Craft: If you repurpose brown paper bags and want to go the extra mile, add some holiday cheer by decorating (use cookie cutters as stamps!)
