Will hold a public hearing for all persons interested in the petition of TIMOTHY DAIGLE for a special permit per Section 3.3.5 *Nonconforming Single- and Two-Family Residential Structures* of the Salem Zoning Ordinance from minimum width of side yard to expand a nonconforming single-family home by adding a second-story rear shed dormer within the required side yard setback to the single-family home at 7 HAYES ROAD (Map 22, Lot 172) (R1 Zoning District).
