Residents and Businesses of Derby Street: Hardy to Orange Street

Re: Notification of the Start of Sidewalk and Roadway Improvement Project – Phase II

This notice has been prepared to inform you that the City of Salem will soon be starting a sidewalk and roadway improvement project in your area. On or about April 3, 2023, the City's Contractor Tasco, Inc. of Belmont, Massachusetts will begin sidewalk work. Please visit the Engineering Department's webpage for this project at: <https://www.salem.com/city-engineer>, to learn if the start date changes for any reason and to find updated schedule information as the project advances.

The scope of work for this project includes removing and resetting the granite curbs on both sides of the street, removal of the existing sidewalk material with new concrete and brick, including handicap accessible ramps at each corner and at crosswalks. The sidewalk segment from Daniels Street to 143 and 145 Derby Street will not be reconstructed as part of this project. At the conclusion of the sidewalk work, the roadway will be repaved. Weather permitting, we expect this work to be completed by the end of July.

Police Details will be on-site to facilitate traffic and pedestrian flow on Derby Street. Abutters should have access to their driveways after hours, unless notified otherwise by the City. On the days when Tasco is working, it is important not to have cars parked in the roadway. No parking signs will be installed prior to work starting.

The work hours for this effort is 7:00 am to 3:30 pm; however, work may continue after 3:30 pm if weather allows, to advance the project as quickly as possible. As the project progresses, your neighborhood will be an active construction site and you should be careful and drive at a reduced speed and walk carefully around the work zone accordingly.
