Re: Notification of water main replacement project in your neighborhood

This notice has been prepared to inform you that the City of Salem will be completing a construction project in your neighborhood to improve the functionality and reliability of the water system by replacing the water main piping, hydrants, and valves on Purchase Street, Berube Road, and Wall Street Court.

Beginning the week of 12/11/23, the City's Contractor (N. Granese & Sons, Inc.) will mobilize to the site and begin replacing the water main. This work is expected to take approximately 2 months to complete, however, the schedule may be extended by the weather.

This work will require several (2 to 3) short-term water service interruptions (3 to 6 hours long) to all properties along Wall St., Wall St. Court, Berube Rd., Purchase St., Ober St., Henry St., and Rawlins St.


Following the installation and testing of the new water piping, the water services will be connected to each building. The contractor will need access to the water meter in each building to be reconnected. On Purchase Street, Berube Road, and Wall Street Court. There will be temporary service interruptions during this time for each property in the project area. You will be given a minimum of 24-hours advanced notification of any planned water service disruptions. However, due to unknown conditions, it is possible that an unplanned water service interruption will be required.

The work hours for this effort are 7:00 am to 4:00 pm. During this project, the area will be an active construction site and residents and visitors should drive carefully at a reduced speed accordingly. On the days when the Contractors are working, it is important cars are not parked in the roadway. No parking signs will be posted in advance of construction and no parking will remain in effect during working hours until construction is complete for that day. Parking access for residents after work hours will be permitted. Police details will be present to assist everyone safely through the work zone and to facilitate traffic management.

To ensure any services you may receive are not interrupted and improve communication between you and the construction team, we have attached a "Continuation of Special Needs Form" for your use.
